

Always/Never Guide

DOUBLE ROMAN COMPOSITE TILE



ALWAYS

- Always lay out the roof so that all horizontal rows have equal exposure.
- Never exceed the maximum exposure of 13-1/2".
- Always install the lower metal eave closure resting comfortably on the drip edge.
- Never let the lower metal eave closure hang over the drip edge.
- Always "hang" or interlock several tiles and align before fastening.
- Never secure one tile at a time, as horizontal alignment will be very difficult.
- Always secure each tile at two points; screws, nails, tie wires, adhesive, etc.
- Never rely on one point, one method; even with small cut pieces.
- Always use Quarrix fasteners, or comparable stainless steel fasteners.
- Never use fasteners that can corrode and fail.

- Always use adhesives that are specially formulated for HDPE plastics.
- Never use general adhesives that will not bond to HDPE.
- Always cover deck with quality ice and water shield and synthetic underlayments.
- Never install tile over existing shingles.
- Always follow installation guide when forming tile flashings.
- Never use typical flat shingle type flashings.
- Always shuffle/mix tile from different bundles and different pallets.
- Never create potential color variations with adjacent bundles or pallets.
